SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. THE EVENT.

A social event, the Clifford Holder Memorial Tour will be organised by Weston-super-Mare Motor Club and will run as a Touring Assembly on Sunday, 13 September 2020 in accordance with the General Regulations of Motorsports UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA and these supplementary regulations. The route will be approximately 70 - 80 miles in length. Due to Covid 19 there are a few differences that will need to be adhered to this year, including the following:

Occupants of cars much live in the same household or from the same support bubble

Social distancing must be adhered to at all times

Stay at home if you know you have been exposed to Covid 19 in the previous 14 days, if you are showing symptoms indicated in the Government guidelines, or if you think you might be infected and are awaiting results of a coronavirus test. Inform us and there will be a refund.

2. **Permit.** A certificate of Exemption number 118744 has been issued.

4. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY.

The event is open to vintage, classic, sports and 'supersports'. Each vehicle must be in a roadworthy condition and with a current MOT Certificate where applicable. The organisers reserve to right to refuse an entry.

5. ENTRIES.

Entries will open upon publication of the regulations.

Please remember to sign your entry form.

Only one vehicle can be entered on the entry form.

Confirmation of entry will be sent by email. If written confirmation of entry is required, please attach a stamped addressed envelope with your entry.

6. **ENTRY FEE.** The entry fee is £20. The maximum number of entries will be 100 vehicles. If the event is over-subscribed, entries will be accepted in order of receipt. There will be a reserve list to cover the probability of non-starters. The closing date for entries is Saturday, 12 September 2020. Preferred method of payment: **BACS. A/c 81860429; Sort Code 40-46-18.** Please include your name, and car registration.

Alternatively, you can pay by card payment either by phone call to Bray and Griffiths on 01934 622637 or by calling in to their premises in person.

Payment by cheque NOT acceptable.

The entry fee will include:

Route Book provided by email.

7. START of the Tour will be in Weston-super-Mare – Dunelm car park.

Check in will be at the same venue commencing at 08.30 after which entrants will be able to buy breakfast from Fin's Burger Van situated in the car park, up until 10am. The signing on process is different from previous years. You will be sent a Competitor's Signing-On sheet, the third page is the signing on page. See the attached pdf for the areas you need to complete. You need to do one page **per person**, so if there are two people in the car we need a form for each person, even if one person is a passenger. You will only be sent the route book if you have completed the entry form and signing-on forms.

8. ROUTE AND FINISH.

A detailed route book will be issued by email a day or so before the event, so you have time to print it yourselves. If you are unable to print this please let us know and we will try and provide one for you. On arrival at the finish at the Rock Café at the bottom of Burrington Combe entrants will be directed to appropriate parking areas.

9. AWARDS.

Judging will take place at the Start and Finish. Awards will be presented at the finish as follows:

- 1) Best Overall Car – The Clifford Holder Memorial Trophy

Any cars who did not check-in at the Start will not be eligible for an award.

9. FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Final Instructions will be emailed to entrants approximately 5 days before the event.

Exact start times will be advised with the Final Instructions and all drivers must have checked in at least 30 minutes before their advised start times.

10. INSURANCE.

Entrants and drivers must have valid insurance in accordance with the requirement of the Road Traffic Act and relevant law applicable in Great Britain. The organising club has full Public Liability Insurance applicable under membership of the Motor Sports Association.

11. CANCELLATIONS.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amend the event if necessary. If the event is cancelled, all entry fees will be refunded.

As previously stated, if entrants have to withdraw for Covid reasons, their entry fee will be refunded.

12. Covid notice.

Entrants contact details will remain on file for 21 days after the event. Should anyone develop symptoms of Covid in the 14 days after the event, this information will be shared with NHS Test and Trace.

The changes to how the route book is supplied, signing on and the social aspect of the event have all been made to ensure we are doing everything we can to reduce any risk of infection. Entrants are reminded to bring a hand sanitizer with them and to use regularly and respect social distancing rules throughout.
